



## Extract from Resolution No. 234/2017 of the Chief Executive Officer of the Budapest Stock Exchange Ltd.

Budapest, June 23, 2017

The CEO of the Budapest Stock Exchange Ltd. decides to delist the equity based BMW, BNP Paribas, Commerzbank, Daimler, Deutsche Bank, EON, Thyssenkrupp and Total futures contracts and removing it from the Product List.

The CEO sets June 30, 2017 as the Last Trading Day in certain maturities of the above futures contracts.

The CEO sets July 4, 2017 as the day of removing the above contracts from the Product List.

### Reasons

Upon authorization by Section 36.2 of the Book Five of the “General Terms of Service of the Budapest Stock Exchange Ltd.” titled Regulations on Trading, the Conciliation Committee set January 12, 2017 as the Last Trading Day in certain maturities of the BMW, BNP Paribas, Commerzbank, Daimler, Deutsche Bank, EON, Thyssenkrupp and Total futures contracts.

At the same time, considering the stipulation contained in Section 32.2.b) of Book Two of the “General Terms of Service of the Budapest Stock Exchange Ltd”. titled Regulations on Listing and Continued Trading (hereinafter: ‘Regulations on Listing’), the Conciliation Committee set July 4, 2017 as the day of removing the above contract from the Product List.

Based on Section 32.2 a) of Regulations on Listing, the CEO has the power to issue decisions on delisting Exchange Products and removing them from the Product List.
